*Vancouver*

**Meals: D**

*Ketchikan*

Enjoy a stop in **Ketchikan**, Alaska, truly the beginning of the last frontier. Set at the southernmost entrance to Alaska's famed Inside Passage—a network of waterways that snake through some of the most jaw-droppingly beautiful wilderness anywhere—Ketchikan is best known for its idyllic scenery, and an incredibly rich Alaskan Native culture.

### Day Four:

*Juneau*

**Meals: B, L, D**

The cruise ship stops in **Juneau**. Experience the magnitude of its towering peaks, cascading streams, bright bursts of wildflowers, and vast, otherworldly icefields.

### Day Five:

*Skagway*

**Meals: B, L, D**

**Skagway** retains the history of the Gold Rush era while serving as a gateway to the extensive wilderness playground of the Yukon. An optional side tour on the **White Pass Scenic Railway** is recommended.

### Day Six:

*Glacier Bay*

**Meals: B, L, D**

The spectacular scenery and wildlife of **Glacier Bay** makes it a highlight of any Alaska cruise. The ship travels into the heart of the **Fairweather Mountains** for a trip into the ice ages. Watch for icebergs and calving glaciers. Scan the shorelines for wildlife...brown bears, mountain goats, sea otters, sea lions, harbour seals, bald eagles, and a variety of seabirds are regularly seen.

### Day Seven:

*College Fjord*

**Meals: B, L, D**

Today we cruise **College Fjord**. The College Fjord boasts the world's largest collection of tidewater glaciers - including the massive **Harvard Glacier** - and countless opportunities to experience the roar of "white thunder", as enormous pillars of ice break off from the glaciers and crash into the surrounding seas.

**Day Eight:**

*Whittier – Denali National Park*

**Meals: B, D**

Disembark the ship in **Whittier** and board the **Direct-to-the-Wilderness rail service**. This journey takes you on a scenic rail journey through some of the most spectacular wilderness as we head to **Denali**. Arrive at the **Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge** set above the **Nenana River Canyon** for a two night stay.

**Day Nine:**

*Denali National Park*

**Meals: B, D**

Enjoy a full day of attractions in **Denali National Park** with a Natural History tour. Learn more about the park's animals, plants, and geological features.

**Day Ten:**

*Denali – Mt. McKinley Wilderness Lodge*

**Meals: B, D**

Depart this afternoon for a journey by coach to **Mt. McKinley Wilderness Lodge**. Take in the sensational views of Denali from the lodge's expansive deck or from their fireside patio. This is a one-night stay.

**Day Eleven:**

*Mt. McKinley – Anchorage*

Travel along the **George Parks Highway** from Mt. McKinley to **Anchorage**. Spend your day on your own exploring Alaska's largest city. Overnight at the **Hotel Captain Cook**.
